सूचना

महाराष्ट्र वैद्यकीय परिषदेला दि. २८.०१.२०२५ रोजी मा. मुख्यमंत्री कार्यालयाकडून प्राप्त झालेल्या पत्रात महाराष्ट्रातील नोंदणीकृत वैद्यकीय व्यावसायिकांना ग्रामीण/आदिवासी/दुर्गम ठिकाणी वैद्यकीय शिबिरे, शस्त्रक्रिया आणि धर्मादाय ट्रस्ट रुग्णालयांमधील मोफत स्वयंसेवेसाठी सीपीडी क्रेडीट पॉईंट्स देण्याबाबत प्रोत्साहित करण्याची गरज अधोरेखित करण्यात आली आहे. सदर सूचनांची अंमलबजावणी करणे ही परिषदेसाठी अभिमानाची बाब असून या सूचनांमुळे स्वयंसेवेचे महत्त्व अधोरेखित होते आणि इतरांनाही प्रेरणा मिळू शकते.

सदर सूचनेच्या अनुषंगाने ग्रामीण आरोग्यसेवेतील तफावत भरून काढण्यासाठी, महाराष्ट्र वैद्यकीय परिषदेकडून नवीन प्रणाली सुरु करण्याचे प्रस्तावित आहे. सदर प्रणाली सुरु करण्यामागचा उद्देश ग्रामीण/आदिवासी/दुर्मिळ भागात आयोजित वैद्यकीय शिबिरे, शस्त्रक्रिया आणि वंचित भागात मोफत आरोग्य सेवा देणाऱ्या डॉक्टरांना प्रोत्साहन देणे, तसेच ग्रामीण/आदिवासी/दुर्मिळ भागातील रुग्णांना वैद्यकीय सेवा प्रदान

करणे असा आहे. त्याचबरोबर सदर प्रणालीमुळे नोंदणीकृत वैद्यकीय व्यावसायिकांना त्यांच्या सीपीडी क्रेडीट पॉईंट्सची आवश्यकता पूर्ण करण्यास मदत होईल.

सबब माननीय प्रशासक डॉ. विंकी रुघवानी म.वै.प. यांच्या मान्यतेनुसार नवीन प्रणाली अंतर्गत ग्रामीण/आदिवासी/दुर्मिळ भागात वैद्यकीय शिबिरे, शस्त्रक्रिया करणे आणि मोफत आरोग्य सेवा प्रदान करण्यासाठी आणि यापूर्वी परिषदेत मान्यता प्राप्त नसलेल्या महाराष्ट्रातील रुग्णालये / वैद्यकीय महाविद्यालये / धर्मादाय / सामाजिक संस्थांना परिषदेकडे मान्यता प्रक्रिया पार पाडावी लागेल. सदर मान्यता प्रक्रियेसाठी रुग्णालये / वैद्यकीय महाविद्यालये / धर्मादाय / सामाजिक संस्थांना आवश्यक कागदपत्रे आणि माहितीसह ऑनलाईन पध्दतीने परिषदेकडे अर्ज सादर करावा. जर रुग्णालये / वैद्यकीय महाविद्यालये / धर्मादाय / सामाजिक संस्थांनी आवश्यक मानके पूर्ण केली तर त्यांना परिषदेकडून स्वयंसेवा प्रदान करण्यासाठी मान्यता देण्यात येईल.

तरी, नवीन प्रणाली अंतर्गत ग्रामीण/आदिवासी/दुर्मिळ भागात वैद्यकीय शिबिरे, शस्त्रक्रिया करणे आणि मोफत आरोग्य सेवा प्रदान करण्यासाठी रुग्णालये / वैद्यकीय महाविद्यालये / धर्मादाय / सामाजिक संस्थांसाठी तपशीलवार मार्गदर्शक तत्त्वे यासोबत जोडण्यात आलेली आहेत.

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MMC/Guidelines Med.Camps-Surgery/2025/ 06329 Date:- 26/11/2025

GUIDELINES FOR HOSPITALS/MEDICAL COLLEGES/CHARITABLE/SOCIAL ORGANIZATIONS HOSTING MEDICAL CAMPS, CONDUCT SURGERIES AND PROVIDE FREE HEALTHCARE SERVICES IN RURAL/TRIBAL AREAS: -

1. With reference to the government letter received by the Council on dt. 28.01.2025, Council granting credit points for hosting medical/surgical camps and provide free healthcare services to the hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations.
2. As per the guidelines, rural/tribal areas are defined as those that fall under the jurisdiction of rural hospitals or primary health centres.
3. The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations must have a clear objective of providing healthcare services to rural/tribal areas.
4. The hospitals / medical colleges / charitable / social organizations conducting medical/surgical camps and free healthcare services in rural areas should ensure quality care and safety for patients.
5. The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations should have all the requisite and demonstrated ability to plan and implement medical/surgical camps and free healthcare services.
6. **Requirements for Medical/Surgical Camps and Free Healthcare Services: -**
 - a) Medical Team: The medical team must include qualified doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals.
 - b) Equipment and Supplies: The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations must provide adequate equipment and supplies and personnel for the medical camp/surgery and free healthcare services.

- c) Patient Selection: Patients must be selected based on medical need and priority.
- d) Informed Consent: Patients must provide informed consent before undergoing any medical procedure.
- e) Post-Operative Care: The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations must provide adequate post-operative care to patients.
- f) All operative procedure should be done at the medical setup registered by the local authority.

7. Accreditation Process:

- a) Application: The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations must submit an online application for accreditation, providing required documents and information.
- b) Inspection: A team from the Council may conduct an inspection to verify the infrastructure, equipment and quality assurance systems.
- c) Accreditation: The Council will grant accreditation to the hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations if it meets the required standards.

8. Eligibility Criteria:

- a) The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations must be registered with the relevant authorities.
- b) Quality Assurance: The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations must have a quality assurance system in place.

9. Accreditation Validity and Renewal:

- a) Validity: Accreditation will be valid for a period of 5 years.
- b) Renewal: The hospitals / medical colleges / charitable / social organizations must apply for renewal of accreditation at least 2 months before the expiry date.

10. Monitoring and Evaluation:

- a) Regular Inspections: Council will conduct regular inspections to ensure compliance with the guidelines.
- b) Feedback Mechanism: A feedback mechanism must be established to receive complaints and suggestions from patients and stakeholders.
- c) Quality Improvement: The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations must have a quality improvement system in place to address any deficiencies or concerns.

11. Penalties for Non-Compliance:

- a) Warning: A warning will be issued to the hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations for non-compliance with the guidelines.
 - b) Suspension: Accreditation will be suspended if the hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations fails to comply with the guidelines.
 - c) Cancellation: Accreditation will be cancelled if the hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations are found to be grossly non-compliant with the guidelines.
- 12.** RMPs will be entitled with maximum of 10 credit hours overall in 5 years and maximum 2 credit points for each camp by participating in medical/surgical camps and free healthcare services in rural areas.
- 13. Application and attendee registration:** - Application for accreditation of the medical/surgical camps and free healthcare services to be made online to MMC website 15 days prior to conduct of medical/surgical camps and free healthcare services in a standard MMC prescribed format which is uploaded on MMC website.
- 14. Time-Stamped photos/Videos:** - Periodic time-stamped photos shall be taken during the medical/surgical camp and free healthcare services which will be subsequently to be uploaded online.
- 15. Feedback:** - Feedback from beneficiaries and medical professionals involved in the medical/surgical camp and free healthcare services to be uploaded online.
- 16. Observers:** - The accredited hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations should choose a Registered Medical Practitioner (RMP) as an observer to oversee the medical camp/surgery and free healthcare service. This observer should be a participant in the camp/surgery and free healthcare service and will verify the attendance of other doctors and observe related aspects of the medical camp/surgery and free healthcare service as per guidelines.
- 17. Runtime:** - Medical camp/surgery, free healthcare services for 3 hrs. shall be granted 1 (one) credit hour. For 6 hrs medical camp/surgery, free healthcare service shall be granted 2 (two) credit hours. Maximum 2 credit points allotted to each medical camp/surgery/free healthcare service.

18. Accreditation/Credit points to be awarded will be the sole discretion of the Maharashtra Medical Council.
19. It will be the responsibility of accredited hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations to see that adequate standards are maintained.
20. The medical camps / surgeries and free healthcare service should not have any product / person advertisement or company / hospital / individual propaganda material.
21. The accredited hospitals / medical colleges / charitable / social organizations will be held responsible for any irregularity in the medical camp/surgery and free healthcare service submitted to MMC.
22. **Medical/Surgical Camp/Free healthcare service post event report:**
Post medical camp/surgery and free healthcare services, accredited hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations should send the excel sheet with Name of RMP, MMC Registration number/any other State Medical Council registration number or NMC registration number, periodic time-stamped photos/videos taken and a detailed report of the medical/surgical camp, including number of patients treated/surgeries performed, outcome of the surgeries, medical professionals involved and beneficiaries to MMC office within 15 days of the medical camp/surgery and free healthcare service to be sent by email, for avoiding any delay in conducting further medical camp/surgery and free healthcare service. The hard copies to be sent by post to MMC within one month.
23. The hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations will be required to preserve the periodic time-stamped photos/videos of the whole medical camp/surgery and free healthcare service for a minimum period of 6 months and the same to be made available to MMC if demand arises.
24. Regular review (Performance Audit) will be done of such hospitals/medical colleges/charitable/social organizations by MMC.
25. All other guidelines prescribed for physical CPD's on MMC website will be applicable wherever required for medical camp/surgery and free healthcare service Guidelines.
