1	<p>Important Notifications: - The Government of India published official gazette notification dated 07/03/2008 for recognition of 5 foreign countries.</p> <div data-bbox="507 241 1241 1099" style="text-align: center;"><p>2</p><p>THE GAZETTE OF INDIA : EXTRAORDINARY [PART II—Sec. 3(ii)]</p><p>MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE</p><p>(Department of Health and Family Welfare)</p><p>NOTIFICATION</p><p>New Delhi, the 7th March, 2008</p><p>S.O. 459(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of the Section 13 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), the Central Government, after consultation with the Medical Council of India, hereby makes the following further amendments in Part II of the Third Schedule to the said Act, namely :—</p><p>In the said Schedule under the heading “Part II Recognized Medical Qualifications Granted by Medical Institutions outside India not included in the Second Schedule”, after the entries relating to the qualification Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D.) in Medical Sciences (Dagastan Medical Institute), U.S.S.R.* and below the explanation of the asterisk (*), the following shall be added, namely :—</p><p>“All post graduate medical qualifications awarded in Australia and recognized for enrolment as medical practitioners in the concerned specialties in that country;</p><p>All post graduate medical qualifications awarded in Canada and recognized for enrolment as medical practitioners in the concerned specialties in that country;</p><p>All post graduate medical qualifications awarded in New Zealand and recognized for enrolment as medical practitioners in the concerned specialties in that country;</p><p>All post graduate medical qualifications awarded in United Kingdom and recognized for enrolment as medical practitioners in the concerned specialties in that country;</p><p>All post graduate medical qualifications awarded in United States of America and recognized for enrolment as medical practitioners in the concerned specialties in that country.”</p><p>[No. V.-11025/11/2007-ME-P-1 (Pt.)]</p><p>DEBASISH PANDA, Jt. Secy.</p></div> <p>Note: - Please note, all the above mentioned qualifications are registrable in the respective countries with their respective medical council/board.</p> <p>At the time of registration of foreign post graduate medical qualification with Maharashtra Medical Council, all the concerned documents will have to be submitted in original for verification.</p>
2	<p>Foreign Medical Graduates: - The qualification of graduation in medicine obtained from Foreign Universities is registrable in Maharashtra Medical Council subject to fulfillment of following conditions.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Recognition of graduation of Concern University by Medical Council of India, New Delhi.2) Eligibility Certificate by Medical Council of India, New Delhi.3) Passing certificate of examination conducted by National Board of Examination, New Delhi.4) Completion of rotating internship of one year after provisional registration from State Medical Council.

MAHARASHTRA MEDICAL COUNCIL ACT, 1965.

No. MMC. 1096/111/96/Act.—Whereas, it appears to the Government of Maharashtra that the courses of studies and examinations prescribed by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Bombay for the additional post-graduate qualifications viz., "D.O.M.S., D.D.V., D.O.R.L., D.ORTHO., T.D.D., D.P.M., D.M.R.E., D.G.P. and F.C.P.S. in Child Health Dermatology and Venereology and Oto-Rhino-Laryngology and Anaesthesiology, not entered in the schedule to the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965 (Mah. XLVI of 1965) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), are such as to secure the possessor by persons obtaining such qualifications of the requisite knowledge and skill for the efficient practicing of their specialised profession by Medical Practitioners;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 28 of the said Act, and in consultation with the Maharashtra Medical Council, Mumbai, the Government of Maharashtra hereby directs inclusion

NOTIFICATION

MAHARASHTRA MEDICAL COUNCIL ACT, 1965.

No. PGM. 1010/C.R.-18 (Part-2)/10/EDU-2.—Whereas, it appears to the Government of Maharashtra that the courses of studies and examination prescribed by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Mumbai for the qualifications of Fellowship of College of Physicians and Surgeons in Medicine [F.C.P.S. (Medicine)], Fellowship of College of Physicians and Surgeons in Surgery [F.C.P.S. (Surgery)], Fellowship of College of Physicians and Surgeons in Midwifery and Gynaec [F.C.P.S. (Midwifery and Gynaec)], Diploma in Gynaecology and Obstetrics (D.G.O.), Diploma in Child Health (D.C.H.), Diploma in Pathology and Bacteriology (D.P.B.), Diploma in Public Health (D.P.H.), Diploma in Family Planning (D.F.P.), Diploma in Anaesthesiology (D.A.), Diploma in Transfusion Medicine (D.T.M.) and Diploma in Tropical Medicine and Health (D.T.M. and H.) not entered on the Schedule to the Maharashtra Medical Council Act, 1965 (Mah. XLVI of 1965) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), are such as to secure the possession by persons obtaining such qualifications of the requisite knowledge and skill for the efficient practising of their specialized profession by Medical Practitioners ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 28 of the said Act, and in consultation with the Maharashtra Medical Council, Mumbai, the Government of Maharashtra hereby directs the inclusion in the schedule appended to the said Act of the said qualifications ; and for that purpose, amends the said schedule, as follows namely :—

In the schedule appended to the said Act, after entry 26, the following entry shall be added, namely :—

" 27. The following Courses of Study and Examinations prescribed by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Mumbai, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, namely :—

- (1) Fellowship of College of Physicians and Surgeons in Medicine [F.C.P.S. (Medicine)],
- (2) Fellowship of College of Physicians and Surgeons in Surgery [F.C.P.S. (Surgery)],
- (3) Fellowship of College of Physicians and Surgeons in Midwifery and Gynaec [F.C.P.S. (Midwifery and Gynaec)],
- (4) Diploma in Gynaecology and Obstetrics (D.G.O.),
- (5) Diploma in Child Health (D.C.H.),
- (6) Diploma in Pathology and Bacteriology (D.P.B.),
- (7) Diploma in Public Health (D.P.H.),
- (8) Diploma in Family Planning (D.F.P.),
- (9) Diploma in Anaesthesiology (D.A.),
- (10) Diploma in Transfusion Medicine (D.T.M.),
- (11) Diploma in Tropical Medicine and Health (D.T.M. and H.).

The Government of Maharashtra further directs that the above qualifications should not be treated as conferring recognised Medical qualifications under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956."

4 Seychelles University :- The candidates who have taken admission for the graduation course before 16/04/2010 will be only eligible for registering their graduate qualification with Maharashtra Medical Council subject to following conditions.

1. Recognition of graduation of concern University by Medical Council of India, New Delhi
2. Eligibility Certificate by Medical Council of India, New Delhi.
3. Passing certificate of examination conducted by National Board of Examination, New Delhi.
4. Completion of rotating internship of one year after provisional registration from State Medical Council.

Please note that, no post graduate qualification is recognized from Seychelles University by Medical Council of India, New Delhi, hence, the Post Graduate Qualification will not be registered with Maharashtra Medical Council.

5 Registration of Additional Qualification: - Registration of Additional Qualification is mandatory as per clause 7.20 of Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulations, 2002. (Additional Registration for P.G. Qualification is done once in life time and don't need any renewal.)

Non registration of additional qualification may invite legal action in future in case of medico legal case/suit and negligency cases in the Council and Hon'ble Court of Law.

Registration with Maharashtra Medical Council is mandatory for the doctors desirable to practice the specialty in the State of Maharashtra.

All P.G. students should register with MMC before starting to pursue P.G. course.

Doctors having registration with other state council will have to procure No Objection Certificate from respective State Medical Council for registration with Maharashtra Medical Council.

Multiple State Medical Registrations are possible if one intends to practice in multiple states.</p>
8	<p>Before starting of internship, one must obtain Provisional Registration from MMC. Internship will not be held valid without Provisional Registration. Online Provisional Registration facilities are available.</p>
9	<p>a) Definitive guidelines exist to conduct any workshop with the help of guest faculty from other states. It will be responsibility of the organizer to get temporary registration with MMC for Guest faculty from other state.</p> <p>b) Definitive guidelines exist to conduct any workshop with the help of guest faculty from abroad. It will be responsibility of the organizer to obtain the permission from MCI followed by Temporary Registration with MMC for Guest faculty from abroad.</p>
